What is a foldable cargo container?

A foldable cargo container looks like a traditional container, but it offers the opportunity of saving space when it's not being used. This type of container can be folded vertically and horizontally with the port's standard machinery and, of course, handled with container spreaders. Why do we need to save space in shipping cargo?

Who makes foldable containers?

HCL is not the only company that produces foldable containers. Another example is Staxxon, an American manufacturer of accordion-like foldable containers. They are ISO approved and will be commercially available in 2023. They can be folded and unfolded by two people or with Material Handling Equipment (MHE).
