Which French doors have double glazing?

Our Master and Elite French door ranges are offered with full-thickness, 24mm low-E double glazing as standard, and our Status and Supreme doors have 28mm units. They have double weather seals to prevent condensation and are compliant with European safety glass standards.

How do glass panels work in a French door?

The glass panels are held in place by glazing beads or stops, which help to secure them within the door frame. Mullions: Mullions are vertical or horizontal bars that separate individual glass panels within a French door. They not only add visual interest but also provide structural support and reinforce the overall strength of the door.

What are the different types of French door glass?

There are a total of three different classes, which are presented below: French door glass of sound insulation class 2 - 32 dB: This standard variant made of 4 mm float glass (inside and outside) and 16 mm space between panes is ideal for less heavily trafficked residential streets.
