Why is Mozambique acquiring 25-30 MW of solar PV?

The procurement of 25-30 MW of solar PV is the first stage of implementation of the program which will contribute to the diversification of Mozambique's power mix and improve power supply quality, whilst ensuring low-cost energy for Mozambican end users

What is a get fit Mozambique tender?

The tender is promoted by the Ministry of Mineral Resources and Energy (MIREME), with funding from the Government of Germany, through the KfW Development Bank, under the GET FIT Mozambique program, and is implemented by the Energy Regulatory Authority (ARENE).

Who owns land in Mozambique?

According to the Constitution of the Republic of Mozambique and as reflected in the Land Law (Law no. 19/97 of 1 October), land is owned by the State, but the rights to use and occupy land can be granted to users in form of a DUAT.
